Ministry Update: 'SHINE CAFE'

Since starting back into our 3rd year of Shine Cafe in September we have had a very encouraging first Term. We have had 8 new ladies from Syria coming along on a regular basis, a lady from Albania, from Egypt and some new ladies from India. Most weeks there are about 8-10 ladies coming. Our theme this term has been 'I See Jesus' - stories from the OT which are a shadow of Jesus. We are able to tell the stories and demonstrate how they point to Jesus, who He is, and what he came to earth to do for us. Please pray for wisdom and sensitivity in these opportunities we have to share God's love.



CARPENTRY MINISTRY: (Tuesdays)

It has been very encouraging this year so far. There have been 4-5 men regularly attending each week, from Iran, Afghanistan, Kurdistan and Sudan. There is a great atmosphere among all the men. We enjoy learning new skills, deepening relationships over coffee and lunch breaks, and using these opportunities to have meaningful conversations about faith. We continue to pray for God to reveal himself to these men and that we can be a small part in that journey.



International Meeting Point, Belfast (Wednesdays and Thursdays)

Avisai now goes 2 days a week, Wednesdays and Thursdays. He leads the Alpha course bible study with a group of 20 Iranians on Wednesdays. (There are approximately 80 Iranian people who come to the Bible study on Wednesdays and split into smaller groups). Avisai really enjoys this opportunity to share the gospel. Thursdays is a more 'practical' day, building relationships by chatting over coffee, discussions, playing pool, and so on. As well as helping to fix things as needed, for example recently going down to IMP a Friday and Saturday to lay a floor and skirting boards for a new office area. He loves these 2 days in Belfast meeting refugees and asylum seekers, however it is also exhausting for him operating in English all day and he comes home very tired physically and mentally. We appreciate prayer for him in this ministry.

Monday and Fridays

Avisai spends Monday in the shed preparing the projects for ministry on Tuesdays. Fridays and Saturdays are for his own part-time carpentry business, however often these days are also taken up with WEC meetings and ministry-related work, leaving him very little time for his own business at the moment. We thank God for the opportunities He has given us to serve him here in Portadown.
