Most of the time, when it is used here, you get the feeling that the person has no intention of doing what they say they will do and it can be quite frustrating when people don't keep their word. But it's not good or healthy to live with frustration all the time and I think as I look back over the last few years, we have really had to learn that things really only happen when God wills it. We can struggle to push things forward and we can try to force things at times, but we have to learn to trust Him, to rely on Him and to let Him work in His time. We want to do our best before God, but the past few years have certainly helped us live more at peace with things not happening the way we planned or wanted and being able to trust that He is still working and it is as much about the journey as it is about the end result.
